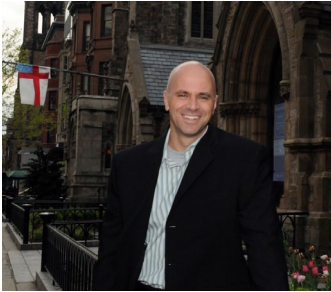

NAURALIZATION CEREMONIES AT FANUEIL HALL

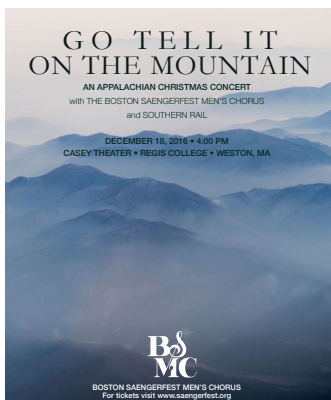
November 10—Faneuil Hall; 12:30-2:00
